The Commission has now decided to conduct an Offline Pen and Paper Based **COMBINED RECRUITMENT TEST** for short-listing the candidates for the above mentioned posts on **04.11.2023 (SATURDAY) (AFTERNOON SESSION) from 02.00 P.M to 04.00 P.M.** Only those candidates shortlisted in Combined RT and who fulfill all the eligibility conditions of the post shall be called for interview.
